

# Docufilm contest launched to encourage organ donation among Filipinos

- The Renal Gift Allowing Life for Others (REGALO) has launched a documentary film contest to encourage more Filipinos to give the gift of life by becoming organ donors.
- The contest challenges participants, whether groups or individuals, to create a short documentary on how organ donation and kidney transplantation benefit many Filipinos.

**Quezon City, June 20, 2019** – The Renal Gift Allowing Life for Others (REGALO), a multi-stakeholder alliance advocating for organ donation and kidney transplantation, has launched a documentary film contest to encourage more Filipinos to give the gift of life by becoming organ donors.

REGALO: A Gift of Life Documentary Film Contest was launched during the National Kidney Month media briefing held today at the National Kidney and Transplant Institute (NKTI), with the theme "Make It Your Mission, Share Your Decision."

For patients with end-stage renal disease (ESRD), a kidney transplant is often the only hope for survival, explained NKTI Executive Director Dr. Rose Marie R. Liquete. "The number of patients with ESRD in the country is increasing. Unfortunately, the number of kidneys from living and deceased donors remains dismally low."

"The docufilm contest is part of our continuing advocacy to promote awareness on the nobility and life-saving benefits of organ donation, and encourage more Filipinos to be organ donors," said Dr. Romina Danguilan, NKTI Deputy Director for Medical Education and Research, and REGALO Organizing Committee Head.

According to Mr. Ben "M7" Yalung, Founder of Asia Pacific Film Institute, character-driven documentaries focused on the stories of real people put a human face on issues that might otherwise seem distant or unrelatable. "Documentaries are powerful tools that can educate and motivate people to do good."

The docufilm contest challenges participants, whether groups or individuals, to create a short documentary on how organ donation and kidney transplantation benefit many Filipinos. It is open to film makers, videographers, students and film enthusiasts. Registration is free. The documentary could be a testimonial or story of a person who is either (1) a recipient of a donated organ; or (2) an organ donor. Only one entry per participant/team is allowed. The documentary should be in digital format (minimum resolution size 720 x 480) and not more than 5 minutes in length. Entries should include written scripts in English, Filipino or Visaya. The criteria for judging are: Composition (30%); Relevance to the Theme (30%); Creativity (20%); and Originality (20%). The grand winner will receive P50,000; second prize is P30,000 and third prize is P15,000. Deadline for submission of entries is October 04, 2019, 5PM.
